Faculty Fellows Program

The Landis Center invites faculty members from within Lafayette to serve as the Faculty Fellow for Engaged Scholarship. The Faculty Fellow will pursue a community-engaged research or teaching project within their area of academic interest.

Projects must follow the Landis Center's Principles for Effective Community Partnerships, but are otherwise open to the researcher's area of interest.

Communication

- The partnership is created to achieve a specific purpose that may evolve over time
- Goals are shared and connected to measurable outcomes and a process of accountability
- Feedback is consistent and focused on improving outcomes

Balance of power

- Partnerships are established according to the needs and assets of both partners
- Partnerships consider the different experiences, knowledge, value systems of all partners
- Resources and benefits of the partnership are shared

Sustainability

- Partnerships recognize the social, historical, and political contexts in which they occur and align goals and outcomes to reflect them
- Partnerships plan for evolution or dissolution where appropriate

Compensation:

- Stipend: \$1,000
- Professional Development: \$500
- Materials: \$250

Deliverables:

- Faculty Fellow for Engaged Scholarship will share findings with the campus community and submit a report to their community partner
- Faculty Fellow will disseminate findings within their academic community
- Faculty Fellow will participate in Landis Center Engaged Scholarship Community of Practice events and workshops
